General Information:

Skates are members of the shark family that have pectoral fins called "wings". They eat mainly crustaceans and other invertebrates they find on the ocean floor, but occasionally take small fish. While most people in North America never encounter skate on their dinner plate, it is served in areas like New England that have a strong fishing and seafood tradition

Dipturus radiata

Fishing Season:

Skate is Harvested the year round, with inshore fishing seasons generally being limited, while offshore fishing runs the entire year round.

Average size and Weight:

Skate wing is generally sold in triangles weighting from 1 to 2 pounds. These triangles are half a wing, so there would be four from a skate.

Sensory Characteristics:

Skate flesh is quite mild, but slightly more gelatinous than that of regular fish. It cooks very quickly and if overcooked breaks up along the corrugations.
